GENERAL INFORMATION

No nonyl phenols or aromatics". Reddy IT is a specialized aqueous formulation that improves application coverage and enhances penetration, use and up take of formulated and non formulated (Tec N Tank) systemic pesticides and foliar fertilizers. Avoid use with contact fungicides.

Ammonium Sulphate

For applicators who have traditionally used Ammonium Sulphate (AMS), a 1% to 2%v/v solution can be used e.g. 1.6 to 3.2 lb / 20 (US) gallons of water per acre. Spray equipment should be rinsed thoroughly after use due to the corrosiveness of ammonium sulphate. (Follow ammonium sulphate label recommendations carefully)

AND OTHER USES

The addition of an adjuvant to some pesticides or pesticide tank mix combinations may cause injury to the foliage and/or fruit of susceptible crops. Prior to the addition of Reddy IT to spray tank mixes, the user or application advisor must have experience with the combination or must have conducted a crop injury trial.

Reddy IT may be applied by Ground, CDA or Aerial spray equipment. For most applications, use enough Reddy IT solution to allow for uniform wetting and deposition of the spray onto leaf surfaces without undue runoff.

Reddy IT may be used to improve the performance of foliar fertilizers, growth regulators and other systemic pesticides.

RATE FOR USE WITH PESTICIDES

Use ¾ qt. – 1 ¼ qt. /100 gallons Reddy IT in the spray tank ahead of mixing pesticides. Use high rate for non-formulated (Tec N Tank) pesticides. Use high rate when rainfall eminent or for large or drought stressed weeds.

(Note: Do not apply Reddy IT to formulated pesticides without trial evaluation data or information)

MIXING

Prior to any pesticide application all spray mixing and application equipment must be thoroughly cleaned. Carefully observe all cleaning directions on the pesticide label.

1. Fill spray tank one-half full with clean water and begin agitation.
2. Add ammonium sulphate (AMS) if desired, at 1-2% wt/v or 8.5-17 lbs per 100 gallons of water
3. Add Reddy IT as required per the water volume rate per acre
4. Allow time to thoroughly agitate and add the required rate of formulated herbicide per acre as per label directions.
5. Continue agitation and complete filling of the spray tank.
6. Allow a few minutes for proper mixing ahead of application.
